Scholarships for Community College Students

- USA TODAY All-USA Academic Team, the Coca-Cola All-State Academic Team and the New Century Scholars Program annually award approximately **\$500,000 in scholarships** to more than **350 students**.
- Guistwhite Scholarships of \$5,000 are awarded annually to 20 students for transfer to senior colleges.
- Hites Scholarships of \$7,500 are awarded annually to five students for transfer to senior colleges.

Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship Program

- Annually awards approximately **30 scholarships** worth **up to \$30,000** per year to students and recent alumni from accredited two-year colleges and community colleges.
- Each campus can nominate two students or recent alumni.
- **Basic eligibility:** Nominees must have at least a 3.5 GPA; have sophomore status by December 31, 2009, or have graduated in the past five years from an accredited two-year college; and plan to enroll full-time in a bachelor's degree program in fall 2010. The Foundation's selection criteria include academic excellence and unmet financial need.
- **Deadline: Campus deadlines vary.** Contact your faculty representative. Nomination deadline is **January 26, 2010**.

Hispanic Scholarship Fund

Community College Transfer Scholarship Program

- Annually awards over **400 scholarships** of **\$1,250 and \$2,500** to students attending or transferring from a two-year college to a four-year institution.
- Students applying may be planning on attending a community college or transferring to any U.S. accredited four-year institution in the U.S., Puerto Rico, the U.S. Virgin Islands, and Guam in fall of 2010 or spring of 2011.
- **Basic eligibility:** Applicants must be of Hispanic heritage; be a U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident; be currently enrolled part-time or full-time at a community college; have plans to enroll **full-time** at a community college or transfer to a four-year, U.S.-accredited institution **full-time**; have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 in the 2010-2011 academic year.
- **Deadline:** Apply online at www.hsf.net by **December 15, 2009**.
